Expression of Interest

1. Background

- 1.1. The West Bengal Forest Development Corporation Limited (WBFDCL) (hereinafter also referred to as the "Authority") came into existence in 1974 as per Companies Act 1956, on the recommendation of National Commission of Agriculture. The Broad Objectives of setting up WBFDCL was to offer timber, non-timber forest produce and value-added forest products at reasonable prices for the public in general, to develop awareness for conservation of nature and wild life through responsible eco-tourism and to uplift social economic status of Joint Forest Management Committees (JFMCs).
- 1.2. Total recorded forest land in the state is 11,879 sq.km., of which 7,054 sq.km. is Reserved Forest, 3,772 sq.km. is Protected Forest and 1,053 sq.km. is Unclassed State Forest, thus constituting 13.38% of the geographical area of the state
- 1.3. These forests are having plants which are of great medicinal value.
- 1.4. WBFDCL is working on long term vision of marketing Seed/ Materials
- 1.5. In light of the above, WBFDC has decided to float this Expression of Interest to identify firm/ companies involved in manufacturing of end use products/ trading of the using the following seeds/ materials:
 - 1.5.1. Sal Seeds (Dry): Sal seed is obtained from the species shorea robusta, and contains 13-14% of oil. The oil is used as a substitute of cocoa butter and also in confectionaries and eatables. The oil cake remaining after oil extraction contains 10-12% of protein and is used as high protein chicken feed. It is also used as organic manure in agriculture
 - 1.5.2. Haritaki Seeds (Dry): Haritaki is held in high esteem in Ayurveda for its properties to prevent and cure diseases. It has enjoyed the prime place among medicinal herbs in India since ancient times. It is called the 'King of Medicines' and is always listed first in Ayurveda because of its extraordinary therapeutic benifits
 - 1.5.3. Behera Seeds: It is a very commonly used fruit both in Unani and Ayurveda, as antioxidant and to strengthen digestive function, and in cases of chronic diarrhea and dysentery, especially in combination with black myrobalan and emblic myrobalan. Fruits are a rich source of gallic acid and ellagic acid.
 - 1.5.4. **Kalmegh Leaves/ Roots**: Used to relieve griping; in cases of irregular stools, loss of appetite; paste made into tablets and cvbonsumed to

- improve digestion and liver function. Roots: Given to children to cure general debility
- 1.5.5. Mahua Flower: Mahua (Madhuca longifolia) belongs to family sapotaceae, is known for its sweet flowers which possess a lot of ethnic values among the tribal people for the development of various fermented and non-fermented food products. The non-fermented products include halwa, meethi puri, barfi whereas fermented products include mahua daaru or mahuli. Because of its numerous phytochemical attributes traditionally it is also used as a medicine for many diseases including headache, diarrhoea, skin and eye diseases. The present review highlights and explore the composition (dry and fresh flowers), utilization, medicinal and nutritive important along with its future prospective to improve the livelihood of the tribal people with the increase chances of the employment. The same is also used for manufacturing Spirit/ Eatra Neutrak Alcohol (ENA), which is used in industries like Paint, Food Processing, Liquor, Pharmaceuticals etc.
- 1.6. This EOI is for identification of Agency who are interested in lifting of at least 2 MT/ annum each of the above products.
- 1.7. The Districts of Bankura, Purulia, Purba Medinipur, Medinipur, Burdhaman, Purba Burdhaman, Jhargram and Birbhum will be the supply points..
