**Terms & Conditions.**

1. Rate quoted should be inclusive of all Taxes.
2. Intending bidders shall have to quote the overall rate. However, if any of the items is not required to be implemented works in the field; bills should be prepared accordingly on pro rata basis based on the offered rate of the successful bidders and item wise allocation of the maximum admissible cost.
3. It is mandatory to pay Minimum Wage, if any, as per the latest Minimum Wage Act. It shall be the discretionary power of the Range Manager to deploy labours from among the JFMC members.



4. The Divisional Manager, Medinipur Forest Corporation Division, shall have the liberty to cancel any part/cluster or the entire quotation without assigning any reasons thereof.
5. The requisite certificate such as PAN, GSTIN, and Bank A/c Details shall have to be submitted along with quotation.
6. PHOTOGRAPHS OF BEFORE AND AFTER WORKS DONE shall have to be deposited by the successful bidders.
7. Work Order shall be issued as per exact field situation. Bill/Tax invoice shall be processed as per actual work done in the field and not based on lowest rate quoted only, subject to the limit mentioned in the table above.
8. **ALL GOVERNMENT REVENUE/PAYABLE FOR THE SUPPLY SHALL BE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE SUCCESSFUL BIDDER. IN CASE OF ANY DISPUTE, WBFDC/MFCD WILL NOT BE A PARTY TO IT.**
9. Work should be done within 07 (seven) days from the date of issue of work order.
10. It shall be the discretionary power of the undersigned to impose penalty to the tune of 10% of the total value of the work in case of delay in completing the work, if applicable.
11. The quotationer/supplier/contractor should have valid license from concerned authority.
12. Sample, if applicable, should be supplied to the concerned Range Manager before quoting the rate through quotation.
13. Broken / Damaged materials / materials of below quality against the sample supplied, if found after receiving by this office, the same should be replaced with new one / fresh supply at the earliest.
14. Guarantee / Warranty of the supplied materials if any, should be indicated in the quotation.
15. Delivery of the materials should be free of cost.
16. The rate offered should be valid for 6 (six) months. However, the same can be increased up to 1 year subject to satisfactory service of the quotationer.
17. Actual work at field level shall be dependent on the field level situation as per recommendation and satisfaction of the concerned Range Manager. Payment will be made based on actual supply / work done.
18. It shall be the responsibility of the successful bidder to pay minimum wages to the labours engaged for the work. In no case minimum wages shall be compromised under any circumstances.
19. Concerned Range Manager will be at his liberty to engage skilled labourers from among the FPCs; but payment as per minimum wage act, shall be required to be made by the contractor concerned.
20. If required, and if so decided by the Range Manager or his higher authority concerned, successful contractor (L1 bidder) has to take up any/all rectification measures without any additional payment.
21. In that case bill shall be prepared accordingly based on the certificate provided by the concerned Range Manager in this regard referring the quotation no. & work order no.
22. Work order will be issued to the successful quotationer as and when required and subject to availability of fund from appropriate authority.
23. In no case, the WEST BENGAL FOREST DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION and/or any staffs of Medinipur Forest Corporation Division, shall be held responsible for any accident/death of the labourer engaged in the field during the time of work. Safety and security shall be exclusively the concern of the successful bidders and he/she shall have to pay the compensation for such incidences as per existing rules.
24. It will be deemed for all participating bidders that they have read and understood every deliberation mentioned here and are agreed to the same. In case of any dispute arises in future in this regard, the decision of the undersigned will be final and binding.

25. Upon completion of works, to the satisfaction of the concerned Range Manager or his higher authority, payments will be made through Bank transfer/Demand Draft/Cheque/Cash whichever is suitable to the undersigned.
26. After successful completion of works/supply up to the satisfaction of the undersigned, the payment will be made as per Finance Department's G.O. no. 4679 F(Y) dated 21.11.2022, after making all necessary deductions from the gross bill. The final 20% of bill amount will only be released after confirming that necessary GST returns have been duly filed by the supplier and the same is reflected against GSTIN B2B of Medinipur Forest Corporation Division. (As per memo no. 932/1A-254/2022 dated 05.04.2022 of the Managing Director, WBFDC Ltd.)
27. West Bengal Forest Development Corporation Limited, or Medinipur Forest Corporation Division, or any staffs of the Division, shall in no way be held responsible under any circumstances for any accident/death of any labourer/ driver etc., due to any reason whatsoever, or damage of vehicle/other property engaged by the contractor, happened in the field during the time of delivery of goods & articles.
